

TRAFFIC ALERT - ROAD CLOSURES

8TH ANNUAL HAPALUA HALF MARATHON

Sunday, April 14th, 2019

The Hapalua Half Marathon is expecting 10,000 (+) participants. We try to minimize traffic disruptions to the general public as much as possible. Coordination with the Honolulu Police Department and Department of Transportation has determined the following traffic closures. Knowledge of these road closures will enable you to plan your travels in advance.

TIPS:

- * Waikiki bound traffic on **Kalakaua Ave.** will be diverted onto Kuhio Ave at Ala Moana Blvd.
- * Waikiki bound traffic on **H1** should take King St. exit to Kapahulu Ave.
- * Access to **Ala Moana Beach Park** will be limited while runners pass at Atkinson & Kamakee intersections. Expect delays from 6:00AM to 7:00AM
- * Access to **Kewalo Basin Harbor** will be limited while runners pass Ward & Ala Moana Blvd intersection. Expect delays from 6:00AM to 7:00AM
- * Access to **Kakaako Waterfront** will be limited while runners pass. Use Forrest Ave. (eastbound). Expect delays from 6:00AM to 7:00AM at Ward Ave., and Cooke Street.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Honolulu Police Department will allow cross-traffic flow once the bulk of the runners have passed. Most roads should be re-opened by **9:00AM**. Please be patient and follow the directions of HPD and Course Marshals.
