**TRAFFIC
ADVISORY**

The Hapalua Half-Marathon is expecting 10,000 (+) participants. We try to minimize traffic disruptions to the general public as much as possible. Coordination with the Honolulu Police Department and Department of Transportation has determined the following traffic closures. Knowledge of these road closures will enable you to plan your travels in advance.

Beginning at 4:00AM, one or more lanes will be closed and/or coned until the athletes complete that section of the course. Roadways will be progressively opened as the athletes clear each area. Tow-Away zones are in effect from **4:00AM until 12:00PM** Sunday.

The Hapalua Start is 6:00AM.

HAPALUA ROUTE

The Hapalua Route runs westbound on Kalakaua Avenue, left onto Ala Moana Boulevard to River Street, right onto River Street, right onto N. King Street, right onto Kapiolani Boulevard, right onto Piikoi Street, left onto Ala Moana Boulevard, straight onto Atkinson Drive, right onto Kalakaua Avenue, left onto Monsarrat Avenue, left onto Diamond Head Road, left onto Kalakaua Avenue to the Finish Line at Kapiolani Park.





THE FOLLOWING ROADWAYS WILL BE CLOSED OR RESTRICTED ON SUNDAY, APRIL 16, 2023



4:00AM - 8:00AM

All Downtown Roads from Beretania Street to Ala Moana Boulevard/Nimitz Highway will be detoured from 4:30AM. Ala Moana Boulevard, including access to Ala Moana Park should be re-opened at approximately 8:00AM.

4:00AM - 8:00AM

Ala Moana Boulevard (eastbound) from Ward Avenue to Atkinson Drive.

4:00AM - 8:00AM

Nimitz Highway (westbound - one lane) from Bishop Street to Ward Avenue. Westbound one lane will be closed and will open after the race passes.

4:00AM - 8:00AM

Nimitz Highway (eastbound) *access to Aloha Tower eastbound only. From River Street to Ward Avenue will be closed and will open after the race passes.

4:00AM - 8:00AM

River Street from Nimitz Highway to King Street closed and will open after the race passes.

4:00AM - 8:00AM

King Street (eastbound one lane) from River Street to Kapiolani Boulevard will remain open.

4:00AM - 8:00AM

Kapiolani Boulevard (westbound lanes open) from King Street to Piikoi Street will remain open.

4:00AM - 8:00AM

Piikoi Street (southbound lane) from Kapiolani Boulevard to Kona Street and will open after the race passes.

4:00AM - 8:00AM

Piikoi Street (northbound lane) from Kona Street to Ala Moana Boulevard.

4:00AM - 8:00AM

Ala Moana Boulevard (westbound lane) *one lane open to Queen Street. From Kailia Road to Queen Street, expect delays at Queen Street and will open after the race passes.

4:00AM - 8:00AM

Ala Moana Boulevard (eastbound lane) from Kailia Road to Kalakaua Avenue and will open after the race passes.

4:00AM - 10:00AM

Kalakaua Avenue (left southbound lane) from Ala Moana Boulevard to Kuhio Avenue and will open after the race passes.

4:00AM - 10:00AM

Kalakaua Avenue (southbound lane) from Ala Moana Boulevard to Kapahulu Avenue and will open after the race passes.

4:00AM - 10:00AM

Monsarrat Avenue (left lane open) from Kalahullu Avenue to Paki Avenue and will fully open after the race passes.



4:00AM - 10:00AM

Monsarrat Avenue (Waikiki Bound) from Paki Avenue to Diamond Head Road and will open after the race passes.

4:00AM - 10:00AM

Monsarrat Avenue (closed at Tennis Courts) from Paki Avenue to Diamond Head Road will be closed at Tennis Courts and will open after the race passes.

4:00AM - 10:00AM

Diamond Head Road (westbound) from Diamond Head Road to Paki Avenue (to Kapiolani Park).

4:00AM - 12:00PM

Kalakaua Avenue (westbound) from Paki Avenue to Monsarrate Avenue and will reopen approximately at 12:00PM.

TIPS:

- * Waikiki bound traffic on **Kalakaua Avenue** will be diverted onto Kuhio Avenue at Ala Moana Boulevard.
- * Waikiki bound traffic on **H1** should take King Street exit to Kapahulu Avenue.
- * Access to **Ala Moana Beach Park** will be limited while runner pass at Atkinson & Kamakee intersections. Expect delays from 6:00AM to 7:00AM.
- * Access to **Kawalo Basin Harbor** will be limited while runner pass at Ward & Ala Moana Boulevard intersections. Expect delays from 6:00AM to 7:00AM.
- * Access to **Kakaako Waterfront** will be limited while runner pass. Use Forrest Avenue (eastbound). Expect delays from 6:00AM to 7:00AM at Ward Avenue and Cooke Street.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Honolulu Police Department will allow cross-traffic flow once the bulk of the runners have passed. Most roads should be re-opened by 9:00AM. Please be patient and follow the directions of HPD and Course Marshals.
